

USE OF ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT BY STUDENTS

Students may be allowed to possess pagers, cellular telephones and other electronic communications devices while on school property or while attending school-sponsored activities on or off school property, as long as these devices are turned off during school hours or while participating in an extra curricular event.

First time violators of this policy are reported to the Principal, who confiscates the device and holds it in his/her office until the end of the school day. Subsequent violations result in confiscation, loss of privilege and forfeiture of the device to the District.

The District assumes no liability if these devices are broken, lost or stolen. Notices of this policy are posted in a central location in every school building and in the student handbooks.
