PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS OF STUDENTS

The district requires physical examinations of students on the following basis:

- 1. Kindergarten children must have a completed health record, which includes a physical examination before being admitted to school.
- 2. A current physical examination by a licensed physician is required of first grade students entering school for the first time.
- 3. Health records are requested of all students transferring into the district schools. If the previous school does not forward a record or if it is incomplete, it will be the parents' responsibility to comply with physical examination requirements for students.
- 4. Students must have a physical examination prior to their participation in interscholastic and intramural athletic programs.

From time to time, the schools may offer examinations for the detection of vision or hearing impairment.

Annually the District will notify parents prior to physical exams or screenings conducted on students except for vision, hearing, scoliosis, or lice checks.
