

ADVISORY COMMITTEES TO THE BOARD

1. Each Board of Education member shall annually nominate individuals to serve on one (or more) of the following advisory committees:
 - Buildings and Grounds
 - Policy
 - Transportation
 - Finance
 - Curriculum
2. Individuals nominated to serve on the Board's advisory committees must be citizens and/or employees of the Columbia Local School District.
3. The Superintendent shall annually invite, in writing, the nominated individuals to serve on an advisory committee of their choice.
4. Advisory committees shall meet on an as-needed basis, but not less than quarterly.
5. The Board member designated by the Board President as chairperson of each Board Committee, during the Board's annual organization meeting, is responsible for:
 - a. Scheduling the time, date, and place of the meeting;
 - b. Determining the topics to be discussed after consultation with the local superintendent;
 - c. Chairing the meeting.
6. The Superintendent shall notify committee members in writing of the meetings, serve in an advisory capacity to each committee, summarize each committee's report, and send a copy of the summary report to each committee member and the Board.
7. The Board President shall serve as an ad hoc member of each committee.
8. Committee members may recommend others to serve on an advisory committee, but only the Board may nominate individuals to serve.
9. The committee is responsible for reporting its advisory recommendations to the Board through the respective committee chairpersons.
