

## FACILITIES PLANNING

The Columbia Board of Education is responsible for the regular operation and orderly development of its physical plant. The Superintendent is the agent to implement the Board's desires. For this reason, the Board will concern itself with both short and long-range planning as it relates to the properties of the school district.

To this end, the Board will follow the policy of having before it at all times a long-term building program to serve as a guide for capital improvements. This program will be subject to systematic study, revision, and extension from time to time and the respective construction projects will be acted upon individually when proposed for implementation.

The Board's building program will be designed to provide adequate facilities to conduct educational programs for all students residing in the district. The building program will be based upon specific Board policies that have been and will continue to be modified to conform to changes in the curriculum, availability of construction funds, changes in enrollments and the results of annual evaluation of facilities. The Board will establish priorities using these and other relevant factors plus the availability of funds.
