

SUPPORT STAFF POSITIONS

Education is a cooperative enterprise in which all employees of the school district must participate intelligently and effectively for the benefit of the children. This school district will employ nonteaching personnel in positions that function to support the educational program. All such positions will be established initially by the Board. For each new position, the Superintendent will develop a job description for approval by the Board.

Although positions may remain temporarily unfilled, or the number of persons holding the same type of position may be reduced in event of de-staffing requirements, only the Board may abolish a position it has created.
