

SUPPORT STAFF DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES

Support staff training and development is essential to the efficient and economical operation of the schools.

All support staff employees are encouraged to grow in job skills and to take additional training which improves their skills on the job. It shall be the responsibility of all building principals and supervisors to assist effectively in the training of any support staff assigned to their respective buildings or departments.

The Local Superintendent may grant absences to attend meetings, conventions, conferences or workshops of local, State or national associations which serve to advance the welfare of the District through the upgrading and strengthening of the support service.
