

STUDENT DRIVING REGULATIONS

1. Students shall drive their automobile in a safe manner.
2. Student shall display their permit in the windshield at all times that the automobile is on school property.
3. Students shall not leave the parking area prior to the end of the school day unless written permission to depart earlier has been obtained.
4. Students shall not return to their automobiles during the school day without special written permission.
5. Students will enter the school immediately upon parking their automobile. No one will loiter in cars or in the parking lot areas.
6. All drivers will have on file in the principal's office proof of automobile insurance for their vehicle.
7. It is the responsibility of the student and the student's parent to assure that the vehicle is safe to operate and meets the state requirements. The administration reserves the right to refuse a permit for a vehicle deemed to be unsafe.

GUIDELINES FOR DISCIPLINE

A driving infraction could result in suspension of driving privileges as well as other disciplinary measures depending upon the severity of the infraction. A driving infraction shall not take place on school property or at school activities off school property. Examples of infractions include, but are not limited to, speeding, unauthorized occupancy, reckless operation, illegal parking, untimely departure, and/or loaning the automobile to other students.
